I now therefore call on all Clubs in the District for:-

- 1 Nominations for District Governor 2018/2019
- 2 Nominations for First Vice District Governor 2018/2019
- 3 Nominations for Second Vice District Governor 2018/2019
- 4 Nominations for the Host Club, 105M District Convention, for the year 2019.
- 5 Resolutions to be submitted for consideration at the District Convention.

The **Closing Date** for Nominations is **30<sup>th</sup> November 2017** and Resolutions is **30<sup>th</sup> November 2017** and they **must** be received on or before that date. It is the responsibility of the Club submitting a nomination or resolution to ensure that the same has actually been received. It is usual for a resolution to be accompanied by an explanatory note, but any resolution or amendment having financial consequences must be accompanied by a full explanation, with figures, of those consequences.

***Delegates attending the District Convention shall elect a District Governor provided that any candidate for such office shall comply with the qualifications for nomination contained in the By-Laws of Lions Clubs International.***

***Delegates attending the District Convention shall elect a First and a Second Vice District Governor, provided that any candidate for such office shall comply with the qualifications for nomination contained in the By-Laws of Lions Clubs International.***

***Resolutions and Amendments shall only be moved and seconded by either nominees on behalf of the Cabinet or registered Delegates on behalf of a Club, or two Clubs when a Resolution is sponsored by more than one Club.***

***A Club seeking to act as Convention Host must supply, in writing, fully costed details of the Host Town, including hotels or other accommodation, meeting rooms, banqueting halls, parking facilities, proposed entertainment.***

Full details of the Social programme and the nominations and resolutions received will be circulated in due course, but meanwhile, it is very important that Club Presidents bring the Convention date to the early notice of their members and encourage as many as possible to attend.

Do not forget that it is your Convention; let us do our best to make it a memorable one.
